Agreements

- Term dates which will normally be in line with the Local Authority
- In year transfers pupils within cluster and outside
- Shared policies in common areas such as attendance
- Attendance-holidays in term time

Transitions

- Year 5 days focussing on vulnerable students including SEND (*TBC*)
- Year 6 and PP visits (Summer)
- Year 7 talk to Year 6 in Summer
- Year 7 transition student and staff voice activity to feedback and inform transition plans
- Family support worker to provide support to targeted students for the schools involved
- Additional visits for vulnerable pupils
- Year 6 transition projects for the last weeks of their year
